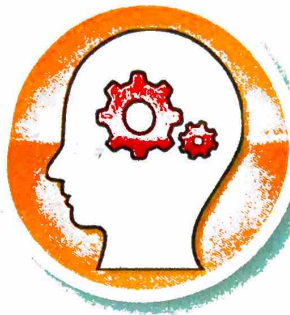


Prevent Childhood Lead Poisoning

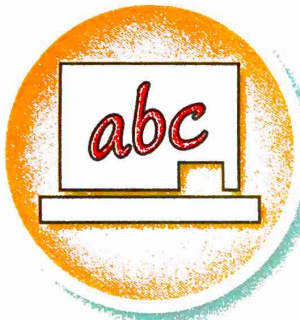
Exposure to lead can seriously harm a child's health



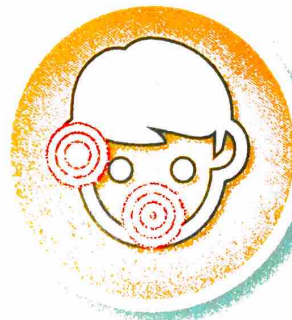
